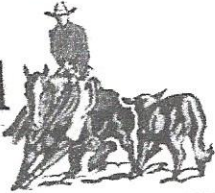

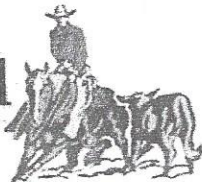

COW WORK SCORING GUIDELINES

75 & higher - Total control, excellent form & position on cow, high degree of difficulty, excellent eye appeal.
73-74 - Good form & position on cow, good control of cow, high degree of difficulty with good eye appeal
